

**NOTICE:
STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS DEADLINE
THE FLINTKOTE ASBESTOS TRUST**

This notice is not intended to supplement or revise Section 5.1(a)(2) of the Trust Distribution Procedures regarding the statute of limitations and repose. For complete information on the statute of limitations and repose, please refer to the Trust Distribution Procedures.

This notice is to make all claimants aware that, pursuant to the Trust Distribution Procedures (the “TDP”), the statute of limitations or repose to file a claim with The Flintkote Asbestos Trust (the “Trust”) will expire for certain claims on **June 14, 2019**.

The controlling guidelines for the statute of limitations and repose are set forth in Section 5.1(a)(2) of the TDP. For claims where there was a diagnosis prior to the Petition Date of May 1, 2004, if the claim meets the tolling provisions described in Section 5.1(a)(2) of the TDP, and the claim was not barred by the applicable federal, state, or foreign statute of limitations at the time of the tolling event, it will be treated as timely filed if it is actually filed with the Trust on or before **June 14, 2019**. Those tolling provisions are:

- (A) the actual filing of the claim against Flintkote prior to the Petition Date, whether in the tort system or by submission of the claim to Flintkote pursuant to an administrative settlement agreement;
- (B) the tolling of the claim against Flintkote prior to the Petition Date by an agreement or otherwise, provided such tolling is still in effect on the Petition Date; or
- (C) the Petition Date.

For those claims first diagnosed after the Petition Date, regardless of any applicable federal, state, or foreign statute of limitations or repose, the claim may be filed with the Trust within three years after the date of diagnosis or within three years after the Initial Claims Filing Date of **June 14, 2016**, whichever occurs later.
